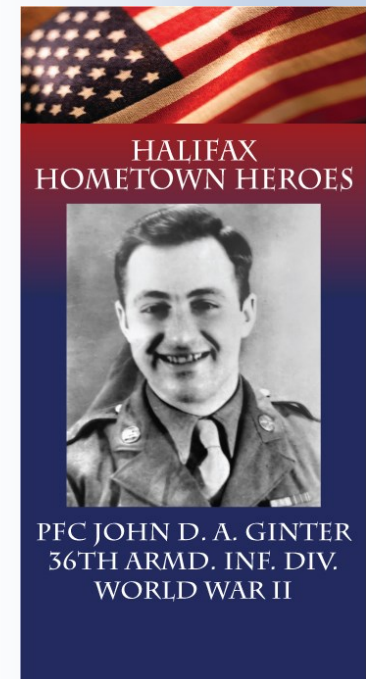

## Eras of Service

### Official US Dept of Veterans Affairs

- **Civil War** -1861-1865
- **Spanish American War** -1898
- **Mexican Border Period**—May 9, 1916 – April 5, 1917
- **World War I** (April 6, 1917 – November 11, 1918)
- **World War II** (December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946)
- **Korean Conflict** (June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955)
- **Vietnam Era** (February 28, 1961 – May 7, 1975 for Veterans who served in the Republic of Vietnam during that period; otherwise August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975)
- **Gulf War** (August 2, 1990 – through a future date to be set by law or Presidential Proclamation)
- **Global War on Terror**-Sept 22, 2001-present

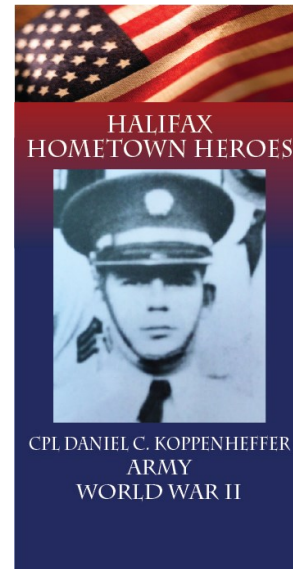
