

ORDINANCE NO. 2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HALIFAX, DAUPHIN COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON
ARMSTRONG STREET

SECTION 1: PURPOSE AND INTENT

The purpose and intent of this Ordinance is to provide for safe and orderly vehicular travel Armstrong Street within the Borough of Halifax, Dauphin County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania allowing residents and non-residents of Halifax Borough to travel unobstructed and freely.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS

Motor Vehicle: Any self-propelled vehicle designed primarily for use on public roads to transport people or goods. This includes passenger vehicles such as cars, trucks, and SUVs, but excludes oversized or specialized vehicles such as recreational vehicles (RVs), buses, or vehicles designed primarily for off-road or commercial use.

Vehicle Owner: An individual or entity holding legal ownership of a Motor Vehicle, as evidenced by a valid title or registration issued by a governmental authority. This includes individuals who have leased or financed a vehicle and are recognized as the primary operator or custodian under the terms of the lease or financing agreement

Armstrong Street: The segment of paved roadway along Armstrong Street in Halifax, Pennsylvania, extending from its intersection with North Second Street (PA Route 147) to the intersection with Walnut Alley, as depicted in Exhibit "A".

Property Owner: Any person who owns or holds tenancy in residential or commercial property along Armstrong Street.

Authorized Parking Zone: A designated parking area available to all individuals, regardless of property ownership status, for a maximum duration of 15 minutes between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

SECTION 3: PARKING PROHIBITIONS

- A. The parking of any Motor Vehicle is prohibited on Armstrong Street at all times, except as permitted under Section 4.

SECTION 4: EXCEPTIONS

- A. Motor Vehicles may park within an Authorized Parking Zone, as designated by appropriate signage, for a maximum duration of 15 minutes between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- B. Property Owners along Armstrong Street shall be exempt from the parking prohibition. Property Owners may park their Motor Vehicles on Armstrong Street, provided the vehicle is properly permitted, through Halifax Borough, to the property owner and does not obstruct traffic or emergency access. This exception does not apply to vehicles that exceed the limits set for Authorized Parking Zones or that are otherwise in violation of local traffic laws or regulations.
- C. Emergency vehicles and service vehicles performing duties for the Borough of Halifax are exempt from this prohibition.

SECTION 5: FINES FOR VIOLATION

- A. Any Vehicle Owner who unlawfully parks their Motor Vehicle on Armstrong Street, as defined by this Ordinance, shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), payable to Halifax Borough.
- B. Failure to pay the initial parking fine within the specified timeframe shall result in a citation being issued. Upon conviction, the violator shall be subject to a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) plus court costs.
- C. In the event of non-payment of the fine and costs imposed upon conviction, the violator may be subject to imprisonment in Dauphin County Prison for a period not to exceed ten (10) days.

SECTION 6: MISCELLANEOUS


- A. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by any court of

competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sentences, clauses, or phrases of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Halifax Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, or phrase not been included herein.


Furthermore, it is the intent of this Ordinance to be supplementary to and not contrary to any laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or regulations of any of its executive agencies.

- B. All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- C. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after Ninety (90) days following its approval.
- D. A satellite diagram labeled Exhibit "A" and attached hereto depicts the North Side of Second Street, Halifax Borough, Dauphin County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


